

Here's a well-structured itinerary for a 11-day bird-watching expedition in Kenya, combining an overland adventure, camping, and fine lodging. The journey covers diverse habitats, from forests and lakes to savannahs, providing excellent opportunities for birdwatching.

Day 1: Arrival in Nairobi

• Travel:

- Arrive at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport early in the morning, meet your guide and prepare for the expedition.
- Drive to Lake Naivasha (approx. 1.5–2 hours from Nairobi).

· Activities:

- Afternoon bird-watching walk along the lake. Spot birds like Haliaeetus vocifer ,Corythornis cristatus , and Balearica regulorum

Accommodation:

- Camping at Camp Carnelly's.

Day 2: Naivasha – Hell's Gate National Park

Activities:

- Full-day exploration of Hell's Gate National Park. Bird species include Aquila verreauxii, Gypaetus barbatus, and Buteo augur.

Accommodation:

- Camping at Camp Carnelly's.

Day 3: Naivasha – Lake Baringo (Tumbili Cliff Lodge)

Travel:

- Drive to Lake Baringo (approx. 4.5 hours).

Activities:

-Afternoon bird-watching along the shores of Lake Baringo to spot Rynchops flavirostris, Ardea goliath, and other waterbirds. Within the compound of Tumbili Cliff Lodge, a birder can spot over 30 species of birds just seated!

Otus senegalensis, Otus leucotis, Verreaux eagle owl, Bubo lacteus, , Burhinus capensis, Cursorius heuglini... rare are these birds, but with our local guides, they are easily spotted!



Accommodation:

- Tumbili Cliff Lodge.

Day 4: Lake Baringo

Activities:

-The Magic of the Lake is discovered early in the morning by a boat ride that takes you to meet the hyppos returning to the water from their overnight grazing, crocodiles sunbathing at the shore and a great variety of the aquatic birds. The boat ride leads to several Islands inhabited by the Njemps, a maa speaking community. Get to meet them and learn their culture

Accommodation:

- Tumbili Cliff Lodge.

Day 5: Lake Baringo – Kakamega Forest (Rondo Retreat Centre)

Travel:

- Drive to Kakamega Forest (approx. 5-6 hours).

Activities:

- Late afternoon bird-watching in the forest. Target species include, Tauraco corythaix, Psittacus erithacus and Tockus subcoronatus
- Accommodation: Rondo Retreat Centre.

Day 6: Kakamega Forest Exploration

Activities:

-Full-day bird-watching in the forest with a local guide. Look out for rare species like Eremomela turneri, Merops muelleri, and Sheppardia aequatorialis.

Accommodation:

-Rondo Retreat Centre.

Day 7: Kakamega – Rusinga Island Lodge in Lake Victoria

Travel:

-Drive to Rusinga Island (approx. 6 hours)

Activities:

-Evening relaxation and bird-watching along the shores of Lake Victoria. Rusinga's grounds are home to more than 369 species of local and migratory birds many not found elsewhere in Kenya

Accommodation:

-Camping at Rusinga Island Lodge.

Day 8: Mfangano Island Excursion

Activities:

-Morning boat trip to Mfanfano Island for bird-watching. Spot species like Anastomus lamelligerus, Vanellus crassirostris and Ceryle rudis



Accommodation:

-Camping at Rusinga Island Lodge.

Day 9: Rusinga Island - Maasai Mara (Ashnil Mara Camp)

• Travel:

-Drive to Maasai Mara (approx. 6-7 hours). The Maasai Mara National Reserve is one of Kenya's most iconic wildlife destinations, renowned for its incredible biodiversity and sweeping savannah landscapes, offering unparalleled opportunities for both bird-watching and game viewing. The reserve is a haven for bird enthusiasts, with over 450 recorded bird species

• Activities:

- Evening game drive with bird-watching. Look for Savannah species like Coracias caudatus, Sagittarius serpentarius, and Balearica regulorum.

• Accommodation:

-Ashnil Mara Camp

Day 10: Maasai Mara Exploration

• Activities:

- Full-day game drives in Maasai Mara, with a focus on birds and wildlife. Target species include Struthio camelus, Ardeotis kori, and Ephippiorhynchus senegalensis. Get ready to search for the "Big Fives" as well: Elephant, Rhino, Lion, Leopard and Buffalo

• Accommodation:

-Ashnil Mara Camp.

Day 11: Maasai Mara – Nairobi

• Travel:

- Morning bird-watching within the camp and then drive back to Nairobi (approx. 5-6 hours).
- Drop off at JKIA for your flight back home or to your Hotel in Nairobi
